These are mostly compatible, that is if you have learned to work in Works 2000, with a bit of help, you can be guided through Works 2007 by taking a course and getting a very good set of 'working notes' and the help of a helpful tutor. By doing this you get the best out of your equipment (How many GADGETS have you that you do not get the most out of ?)

If you wish to proceed further, and that does seem to be the 'norm', The club runs Word Processing stages one, two and three. Internet training, using Outlook Express for email, 'Surfing the Net' Using Internet Explorer...Scanning, (copies documents and photos to Email to friends and relatives ..Cashbook (great program for Club Treasurers) Learn to make Cards and Calendars using Word. The Club Rooms are open 2-4 pm Wed and Fridays
